Transition to School



NSW Health's Rapid Antigen vs PCR Testing

Last week NSW Health posted about the difference between Rapid Antigen and PCR tests on Facebook. The post highlights the fact that if someone has any symptoms of COVID-19 or are identified as a close or casual contact, they should have a PCR test and self-isolate. This is the most accurate COVID-19 diagnostic test.

As per Department of Health guidelines, a PCR test is required by students who are unwell, even with mild symptoms. Students will need to get tested for COVID-19 PCR test and follow NSW Health directions.
